In 1990 his started his own travel and tourism agency, which he successfully managed until 2002 when he sold his business to Atlantic Travel Inc. He has severed as the Secretary General of AETTA since 2005.

"I am very pleased that my efforts and acclaimed and appreciated. I have been with the Association for twelve years already but I am as excited and motivated as ever to continue working with AETTA. I also want to take this opportunity to thank my team members, who have greatly and productively supported me over the years." said Helmut Messner.
