XIth Biennial Congress of AETTA to be held on November 20-22, 2017 in Prague

The Association of European Travel and Tourism Agencies (AETTA) will hold its XIth Biennial Congress on November 20-22, 2017 in Prague, Czech Republic. The AETTA Biennial Congress is a high-profile event that brings together members of AETTA as well as a number of prominent guests and speakers. In addition to being a great networking event the AETTA Congress is also an opportunity to exchange views and ideas on business issues as well as a discussion on the current state of the European travel and tourism sector and on its development prospects.

AETTA welcomes proposals for papers, panels and workshops relevant to the travel and tourism sector in the pan-European context. The selected proposals will be included in the official agenda of the Congress. All proposals must be submitted to AETTA by July 31, 2017 latest.

The previous AETTA's Biennial Congress took place on November 18-20, 2015 in Lisbon and was attended by well over 400 delegates; some 93% represented AETTA members.
